

Statement of Attainment

HLTAID004: Provide an emergency first aid response in an education and care setting

(Includes HLTAID001 Provide CPR and HLTAID003 Provide First Aid)

This qualification satisfies the requirements for the Australian Children's Education and Care Quality Authority (ACECQA) for the provision of first aid, anaphylaxis and asthma emergencies in a child care workplace.

This Unit of Competence (UOC) provides participants with the knowledge and skills to respond to an emergency situation in a safe, confident and competent manner applying the principles of 'best practice' first aid response specifically to infants, children and adults

This unit also includes HLTAID003: Provide First Aid which satisfies the various Occupational Health and Safety (OHS) and Work Health and Safety (WHS) Acts and Codes of Practice associated with the provision of first aid in the workplace.

There are four essential outcomes to this UOC

1. Respond to an emergency situation
2. Apply appropriate first aid procedures
3. Communicate Details of the Incident
4. Reflect on incident and own performance



• TRAINING DURATION

8 hours face-to-face training session + online learning module for participants without a current first aid certificate

• QUALIFICATION DURATION

Recommended every 3 years

• ASSESSMENT REQUIREMENTS

At completion of face-to-face training, each participant will be required to do:

1. **Theory Paper:** Multiple Choice questions (Selection from A, B, C, D).
2. **Resuscitation Practical.** Demonstrate competent resuscitation technique on a mannequin
Note: All participants must demonstrate two minutes of continuous CPR on an adult mannequin placed on the floor
3. **Practical Scenario.** Participants work in pairs, and demonstrate competent bandaging and slinging techniques in controlling bleeding and fracture management. Scenarios also include the use of an autoinjector for anaphylaxis and a spacer device for asthma.
